

ALTERNATIVELY FUELLED VEHICLES ACCOUNTED FOR 47.1% OF TOTAL PASSENGER CAR REGISTRATIONS IN 2022

2022 was a strong year for alternatively fuelled vehicles but conventional fuel types still dominated EU car sales in terms of market share (52.8%) in 2022. Alternatively fuelled vehicles accounted for 47.1% of the total passenger car sales across the EU, a significant increase from 2019 to 2022 (11% to 47.1%, respectively). Stimulus packages introduced by governments to boost demand, following the unprecedented impact of Covid-19 on car sales, sought to stimulate alternatively-powered vehicles in particular, further driving demand for low and zero-emission cars.
