

## FuelsEurope elected as Vice-Chair of the Fuel Production Pillar in the RLCF Alliance's Programme and Monitoring Group

**Brussels, 28 April 2025:** The election marks a key milestone in FuelsEurope's strategic contribution to the RLCF Alliance and the key role of European fuels manufacturers in the deployment of renewable and low-carbon fuels.
